The law also prohibits the sale, hire, or transfer of wireless apparatus in any manner to any person, who is not in possession of a valid license issued in his name. Any attempt to enter the frequency used by the licensed band is also an offence under the above said Acts. All buyers and sellers are required to mandatorily comply with provisions.
