This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. Accordingly, sellers intending to avail payment through TReDS are required to be registered with at least one TReDS exchange in which the buyer is registered.

1. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for % (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

2. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

A. This is to hereby inform all the bidders that technical specification and detailed scope of work is enclosed along with this bid. All bidders have to adhere to them at the time of quoting their rates and subsequently during execution of the work.

B. Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure:

Bidders may note that the Owner (POWERGRID) has uploaded its 'Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure': Vol-I & Vol-II to POWERGRID's website.

Those bidders who wish to peruse the same may visit www.powergrid.in. However, it shall be noted that no other party, including the Bidder/ Contractor, shall derive any right from this 'Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure' documents or have any claim on the Owner on the basis of the same.

The respective rights of Owner and Bidders/ Contractors shall be governed by the bidding documents/ contracts signed between the Owner and the Contractor for the package. The provisions of bidding documents shall always prevail over that of 'Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure'.

C::Minimum Local Content Declaration:

Bidders are requested to provide the Self Certification regarding the Minimum Local Content inline with GeM Portal.

D: Payment Terms:

D.1 The payment to the Contractor under the Contract will be made by the owner as per the guidelines and conditions specified hereunder.

D.2 No Initial Advance shall be paid to the contractor.

D.3 (a) Progressive payment 90 % of the executed work along with submission of documents.

(b) Balance 10 % shall be paid after issuance of Work Completion Certificate by respective Engineer in Charge.

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E. Payment Procedures:

E.1 The Purchaser shall make payments promptly within thirty (30) days of submission of an invoice/claim by the Supplier, complete in all respects and supported by the requisite documents and fulfillment of stipulated conditions, if any. The invoice shall be submitted by the Supplier to the respective Consignee.

E.2 All payments under the Contract shall be made in Indian Rupees.

E.3 All the payments to be made directly to the Contractor shall be made by the Purchaser through electronic payment mechanism (e-payment) for which necessary details shall be tied up during execution of the Contract .

E.4 Payments shall be released by POWERGRID Payment Processing and Facilitation Center (PPFPC) Bhubaneswar against payment advice issued by the Consignee/Engineer-in-Charge.

E.5 Bill Tracking System Prior to submission of bills in physical form, the Contractor shall submit its bills using POWERGRID's Vendor Bill Tracking System as per procedure detailed herein below. Further, the Contractor may track the status of its bills using POWERGRID's 'On-line Vendor Bill Tracking System'. To use this system the Contractor is required to get itself registered once online at POWERGRID's ERP Portal with the link URL (<https://vendor.powergrid.in>). Once registered, the Contractor may track status of bills submitted, passed and paid by POWERGRID's Corporate Centre and Regional Office under this Contract and other Contracts awarded on it by POWERGRID by following the method detailed herein below:

a) Once registered, the Contractor can login to POWERGRID's Vendor Bill Tracking System (BTS) with Vendor login ID and Password.

b) After login as at (a) above, Contractor is required to make the entry on POWERGRID's ERP portal under the tab "Submit new Invoice" and shall fill all details along with the MSE status. Upon submission, a 16-digit unique BTS number will be generated and the Contractor will receive an automated email forwarding the unique BTS number.

c) The option to attach the soft copies of the documents has been enabled in BTS at <https://vendor.powergrid.in> The attachment can be done after creation of BTS ID

E.6 Applicable income tax, as per the prevailing rules in India, shall be deducted at source from the above payments and only the net payment shall be released. Necessary Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) certificate shall be issued to you.

E.7 POWERGRID is registered on TReDS (Trade Receivables Discounting System) platforms namely i.e. RXIL (Receivable Exchange of India Limited), M1-xchange (Mynd Solutions Private Limited) and Invoicemart (A TReDS Limited) and the facility of the same may be availed by Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME)

F. Warranty / Defect Liability period: Not Applicable.

G. Quantity Variation: +/- 25%

H. It is the Employer's (POWERGRID's) policy that requires the bidder to sign a declaration along with its bid about abiding by a 'Code of Integrity for Public Procurement'. All bidders are required to submit the same as a part of their technical bid. This policy is detailed in the bidding documents.

I. Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC), Bid Forms and Qualification Requirements against this tender package is enclosed as "Buyer uploaded ATC document" to this bid document. Bidder shall ensure to submit an acceptable Bid Security/EMD (*if applicable*), mandatorily submit all documents in support of Qualification Requirements and all the Bid Forms duly filled, signed, completed and submit the same (*if applicable*) as a part of their technical bid. Further bidder shall quote the prices in the BOQ enclosed in the subject bid.

J. Bidder shall comply with all terms and conditions as detailed in the bidding documents. Bids not conforming to this requirement are liable to be rejected.

K. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by POWERGRID, and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Bidder by correction of the nonconformity. POWERGRID's determination of a bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.

L. Order of Precedence:

- k) Tender Drawings.; (*if applicable*);

- o) GeM SLA

2. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE 25% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider

3. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.

12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.
