This Bid provides for Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) as Preferred mode of payment. For MSME sellers, payments may be processed through a TReDS exchange in which the Buyer is registered, subject to applicable policy and regulatory guidelines. 1. 2. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within $L-1+ 15\%$ (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM_No.1 4 2021_PPD_dated_18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
 2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider

4. Service & Support

AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Consignee. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO BE SUBMITTED.

5. Past Project Experience

ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS (ATC)

1. QUALITY & TECHNICAL COMPLIANCE

1.1. The work shall be carried out strictly in accordance with:

- a) Scope of Work and Technical Specifications of this Tender.
- b) Manufacturer's Product Data Sheet (PDS), Technical Data Sheet (TDS), Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS), application guidelines and recommendations.
- c) Relevant ASTM/IS Standards, wherever applicable.
- d) Instructions of the Engineer-in-Charge (EIC).

1.2. Surface preparation shall be carried out by mechanical methods such as grinding, scarifying and/or shot blasting as recommended by the manufacturer. Acid etching shall not be permitted.

1.3. The complete flooring system comprising Primer, Body Coat and Top Coat shall be supplied by the same approved manufacturer. Mixing of products from different manufacturers shall not be permitted.

1.4. Proper mixing ratios, pot life, recoat interval, curing time and application sequence recommended by the manufacturer shall be strictly followed.

1.5. All materials shall be applied only under suitable ambient and substrate conditions as recommended by the manufacturer.

1.6. The Engineer-in-Charge reserves the right to inspect the work at any stage and reject any material or workmanship not conforming to the Tender Specifications.

2. MATERIALS

2.1. All materials shall be new, unused and supplied in original sealed manufacturer's containers bearing product identification, batch number, manufacturing date and expiry date.

2.2. Only products of the approved manufacturer quoted in the Technical Bid shall be used.

2.3. Product substitution after award of work shall not be permitted without prior written approval of AIESL.

2.4. The contractor shall submit Product Data Sheet (PDS), Technical Data Sheet (TDS) and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) of all products before commencement of work.

3. PROTECTION OF EXISTING FACILITIES

3.1. The contractor shall adequately protect adjoining finished surfaces, hangar flooring, equipment, utilities and aircraft from dust, debris, damage and contamination during execution.

3.2. Any damage caused during execution shall be made good by the contractor at his own cost to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Charge.

4. DEFECT LIABILITY:

4.1. The work shall be covered under a 12-month Defect Liability Period from the date of successful completion.

4.2. 5% of the final certified bill amount will be retained by AIESL, and shall be released after successful completion of the 12-month Defect Liability Period.

4.3. During the Defect Liability Period, any defect including:

- a) Peeling
- b) Delamination
- c) Blistering
- d) Cracking
- e) Loss of adhesion
- f) Surface failure

g) Premature coating failure

shall be attended within 48 hours of intimation and rectified within 07 days at no additional cost to AIESL.

4.4. In case of failure, AIESL shall be at liberty to carry out the rectification through another agency at the risk and cost of the contractor.

5. RISK & COST:

If the contractor fails to execute or complete the work, rectify defects or fulfil contractual obligations, AIESL reserves the right to execute the balance work through an alternate agency at the risk and cost of the contractor. Any additional expenditure incurred shall be recoverable from the contractor.

6. INSURANCE:

The contractor shall maintain adequate insurance covering Workmen Compensation, Third Party Liability, Damage to AIESL property arising during execution. Proof of insurance shall be produced on demand by AIESL.

7. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

5.1 If the Contractor fails to complete the work within the stipulated completion period, AIESL shall be entitled to recover Liquidated Damages at the rate of 0.5% of the value of delayed work per week or part thereof, subject to a maximum of 5% of the total Work Order Value.

5.2 In case of inordinate delay, the maximum deduction may extend up to 10% of the Work Order Value.

5.3 Delay exceeding 25% of the stipulated completion period shall be treated as inordinate delay.

5.4 In case of continuous delay, AIESL reserves the right to cancel the Work Order.

5.5 Major deviations in specifications or compromise in quality shall be dealt with separately. Recovery of differential cost, quality-related penalty and other contractual remedies shall be applicable.

5.6 Liquidated Damages shall be recoverable from bills, Performance Security or any amount due to the contractor.

8. PAYMENT TERMS

8.1. No advance payment shall be admissible.

8.2. Payment shall be released within 30 days of submission of a commercially correct invoice, subject to:

- a) Certification by the Engineer-in-Charge.
- b) Successful completion of work.
- c) Submission of all required documents.

8.3. The contractor shall submit:

- a) Commercially Correct Tax Invoice
- b) Joint Measurement Sheet

9. GST & SEZ COMPLIANCE

9.1. The supply is meant for an SEZ Unit and shall comply with applicable GST provisions governing zero-rated supplies.

9.2. The successful bidder shall comply with all statutory documentation requirements including submission of LUT/Bond wherever applicable.

9.3. Invoices shall contain all mandatory endorsements prescribed under GST law for supply to SEZ.

9.4. Failure to comply with statutory GST documentation requirements shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

10. COMPLETION SCHEDULE

- 10.1. The contractor shall commence the work within 07 days from the date of issue of Work Order.
- 10.2. The work shall be completed within 30 days from commencement of work.
- 10.3. The contractor shall submit a detailed work execution plan before commencement.
- 10.4. Work shall be executed in a planned manner without affecting aircraft maintenance operations.
- 10.5. The work shall be carried out only during the timings permitted by the Engineer-in-Charge.
- 10.6. The contractor shall coordinate daily with the user department and ensure that execution does not interfere with aircraft maintenance activities.

11. MEASUREMENT

- 11.1. Measurement shall be jointly recorded by the Contractor and Engineer-in-Charge on the basis of the actual repaired area executed.
- 11.2. Payment shall be made only for the actual measured quantity.
- 11.3. The quoted rate shall remain firm and inclusive of all materials, labour, machinery, tools, testing, transportation, repairs, curing and incidental works required for satisfactory completion.
- 11.4. No additional payment shall be admissible on any account.

12. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- 12.1. The contractor shall comply with all applicable safety regulations, MSDS and AIESL safety procedures.
- 12.2. The contractor shall provide appropriate PPE including:
 - a) Safety Helmet
 - b) Safety Shoes
 - c) Safety Goggles
 - d) Gloves
 - e) Respiratory Protection, wherever required
- 12.3. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any accident, injury, damage to property or third-party liability arising out of execution of the work.

13. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 13.1. Bids shall be unconditional.
- 13.2. AIESL reserves the right to seek clarifications during technical evaluation.
- 13.3. AIESL reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason.
- 13.4. Amendments, corrigenda and extensions shall be notified only through the GeM Portal and/or AIESL website.
- 13.5. All disputes shall be governed by the terms of the Work Order and applicable laws of India.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.

14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
