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1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

3. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 60% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of

cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

Terms & Conditions

for

Supply of Veterinary Medicines

(GeM Tender)

1. Introduction

These Terms & Conditions govern the procurement of veterinary medicines, and feed supplements through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM). All suppliers participating in this tender must comply with GeM rules, GFR 2017, the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, and Animal Husbandry Department guidelines.

2. Scope of Supply

1. The selected supplier shall supply veterinary medicines strictly as per the dosage, species category, pharmacopoeia standards (IP/BP/USP/FVM), and specifications mentioned in the Purchase Order (PO).
2. The following veterinary medicines are required in as per the composition and quantity.
3. All supplies shall conform to veterinary usage standards and must originate from licensed veterinary drug manufacturers.

3. Eligibility & Mandatory Documents

The bidder must upload the following documents on GeM:

1. **Valid Veterinary Drug License** issued by competent authority.
2. **GST Registration Certificate**.
3. **PAN Card** of the firm/owner.
4. **Manufacturer Authorization Certificate**.
5. **Non-blacklisting/self-declaration certificate**.
6. **Cold chain compliance certificate** (mandatory for vaccines).
7. **Past experience of supply to Animal Husbandry Departments/Hospitals**.

4. Quality Standards for Veterinary Medicines

1. All veterinary medicines must comply with standards under:
 - o Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940
 - o Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Regulation of Quality Standards)
 - o Indian Veterinary Pharmacopoeia
2. All medicines must be manufactured by GMP/WHO-GMP compliant manufacturers.
3. The following will not be accepted:
 - o Damaged, wet, or tampered packaging.
 - o Reprocessed, relabelled, or re-packed items.
 - o Near-expiry products.
 - o Unregistered/unapproved veterinary drugs.

4. Labelling must clearly state **“For Veterinary Use Only”** wherever applicable.

5. Shelf Life Requirements

1. All veterinary medicines must have minimum 75% shelf life remaining at time of delivery.
2. Vaccines must be from latest batch, preferably not older than 3 months from date of manufacture.
3. Hormones and biological with sensitive stability must meet required cold chain standards (2–8°C).
4. Items failing shelf life criteria will be rejected.

6. Packaging, Handling & Cold Chain (Mandatory for Vaccines)

1. All items must be delivered in original sealed manufacturer packing.
2. Cold-chain-maintained items such as vaccines must be transported using:
 - o Insulated cold boxes
 - o Ice packs
 - o Digital temperature data loggers (if required)
3. Temperature must be maintained between **2–8°C** without fluctuation.
4. The Department reserves the right to reject shipments with broken cold chain or improper storage.

7. Delivery Terms

1. The supplier must deliver veterinary medicines within the time specified in the GeM Contract/PO.
2. Delivery location is Chief Animal Husbandry Office Kargil
3. Transportation, transit insurance, loading and unloading charge and handling costs shall be borne by the supplier.

8. Inspection, Sampling & Acceptance

1. Items will be inspected by a committee constituted by the Animal Husbandry Department Kargil.
2. Random samples may be sent to Government/NABL-approved laboratories for quality testing.
3. If any sample fails:
 - o entire batch will be rejected,
 - o replacement must be done within 7 days,
 - o Cost of testing will be recovered from the supplier.
4. Final acceptance will be recorded only after full verification.

9. Rejection, Replacement & Liquidated Damages

1. Medicines will be rejected if found:
 - o Substandard or contaminated
 - o Without proper labelling
 - o With short expiry
 - o Not matching ordered brand/specification
2. Supplier must replace rejected items within **7 working days** at no extra cost.
3. As per GeM rules, LD/penalty for delayed supply may apply:
 - o **0.5% of order value per week** , maximum **10%**.
4. Repeated non-compliance may lead to:
 - o Contract termination
 - o Suspension/debarment from GeM
 - o Forfeiture of performance security (if applicable)

10. Price, Taxes & Payment Terms

1. Prices quoted on GeM shall be **inclusive of GST, transportation, handling, insurance, and delivery charges**.
2. No additional charges will be entertained after contract finalization.
3. Payment will be made through **GeM Invoice System** only after:
 - o Successful delivery
 - o Inspection and acceptance
4. No advance payment shall be considered.

11. Warranty & Post-Supply Responsibilities

1. Supplier shall provide warranty against any manufacturing defect, fraud, contamination, or product recall.
2. If any veterinary medicine is recalled by the manufacturer or regulatory authority, supplier must provide replacement free of cost.
3. Supplier must support in any adverse event reporting related to vaccines or injectable drugs.

12. Contract Cancellation

The purchaser reserves the right to terminate the contract for:

1. Delay in supply
2. Supply of substandard medicines
3. Breach of terms and conditions
4. Misrepresentation or submission of false documents

5. Repeated quality failures
6. Actions shall be taken as per GeM and government procurement norms.

13. Confidentiality & Compliance

1. All information and documents related to the tender shall remain confidential.
2. Supplier must comply with all **GeM General Terms & Conditions, GFR 2017**, and government guidelines for veterinary drug procurement.

14. Arbitration & Legal Jurisdiction

1. Any dispute shall be resolved as per GeM dispute resolution mechanism.
2. Jurisdiction of any legal proceedings shall lie in the **court of the purchaser's district**.

15. The Client reserves the right to:

1. **Increase or Decrease the Quantity:**

The Client may, at its sole discretion, increase or decrease the quantity of the items/medicines mentioned in the tender at any stage—either before the award of the contract or during the execution of the contract—based on actual field requirements, budget availability, administrative considerations, or any unforeseen circumstances. The supplier shall be bound to accept such variations in quantity at the same rates, terms, and conditions as specified in the tender and the resultant contract.

2. **Cancel, Postpone, or Modify the Tender:**

The Client reserves full authority to cancel, postpone, withdraw, or modify the tender process, wholly or in part, without assigning any reason. This may include situations where the budget provision is revised, delayed, curtailed, or withdrawn, or where administrative, technical, operational, or policy-related circumstances warrant such action. In such cases, the Client shall not be liable for any claim, compensation, or financial loss incurred by any bidder due to the cancellation or modification of the tender.

8. Successful bidder shall submit the performance security @3% of contract value.

9. Forms of EMD and PBG: Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per Gem GTC). DD should be made in favour of **Chief Animal Husbandry Officer, Kargil**.

10. **"NOT FOR SALE"** are **not printed or mentioned** on the outer cover or strip of the medicine.

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and
- All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
