Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

Buyer (User department) Added ATC:

1. The Explosive Van shall be engaged through NIT in reimbursement of POL @ 01 Liter for 12.0 KM run and reimbursement of 01 Liter MOBIL is for 500 K M run.
2. The applicants should own an Explosive Van with commercial registration or should have acquired / booked a new PICK-UP (prior to the date of submission of Application) in Jharkhand.
3. The vehicle shall not be more than 1 (One) year old prior to the last date of submission of application w.r.t. the date of purchase / registration as new vehicle.
4. Explosive Van will be engaged for 24 Hrs. basis with 2 drivers.
5. The successful bidder will have to obtain necessary license required from PESO and other authorities for Explosive Van at their own cost.
6. Vehicle must comply with Explosives Act, 1983 and Explosives Rules, 2008.
7. Vehicle must be registered under Motor Vehicles Act for carriage of explosives.
8. Vehicle must have valid license from Chief Controller of Explosives (PESO) for transportation.
9. The successful bidder must submit all relevant permits, licenses, and safety certificates after LOA and prior to issue of Work Order.
10. Explosive Van body to be fabricated on new Pick Up Van.
11. Explosive Van must have:

12. The Drivers engaged in the Explosive Van will be paid in line with the direction of Coal India Limited vide letter no. CIL/C-5B/JBCCI/Apex JCC/311 Dated 11-08-2022 for payment of minimum wages of Skilled Category of Central Government Minimum Wages to the Drivers of light vehicles in mines. The escalation of rate of wages will apply due to revision in DA from time to time.
13. The reimbursement of POL & Mobil on monthly basis shall be released based on the bill duly certified by the user department regarding running of the vehicle during the month along with total KM run.
14. The payment of wages to Drivers shall be made through Bank. Area HR Manager or the executive duly authorized by the Area General Manager is to certify the payment of the wages based on documentary evidence submitted by the Applicant before release of Bills for payment.

16. Driver should have valid Driving License and should be well disciplined, well behaved, and punctual, not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol during duty hours and have no criminal records. He must be acquainted with basic repairing and maintenance of the vehicle.
 17. **SECURITY DEPOSIT:** Performance Security (first part of security deposit) should be 5% of annualized value of contract amount and should be submitted within 21 days of issue of Work Order by the successful bidder in the form of DD made in favour of Eastern Coalfields Limited Payable at Mahagama. Further, retention money shall be deducted @ 5% or at an applicable rate, as will be decided by the company.
 18. The Rate for hiring of Explosive Van shall be firm for the entire period of contract. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
