Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. - v. For contracts involving supply of multiple items, weighted average of all items to be taken while calculating the local content. **In such tenders, bidders should quote percent age of local content against each item of the bid.**

In case of item-wise tenders, where evaluation is done for each item and each item is awarded to L1 bidder for that item, the aforesaid procedure shall be followed item-wise.

If negotiation happens with the L1 bidder, the margin of purchase preference (L1+20%) should be calculated based on the original L1 price, not the lower negotiated price, and such eligible Class-I Local Suppliers shall be called to match the new negotiated L1 price as per procedure mentioned above.

uch cases, a penalty up to 10% of the contract value may be imposed. However, contract once awarded shall not be terminated on this account.

A supplier who has been debarred / banned/ **suspended in GeM/ tendering portal** by any other procuring entity for violation of PPP-MII Order shall not be eligible for evaluation/ preference, as applicable for the duration of the debarment. A confirmation in this regard shall be submitted by the Bidder along with the bid. In case of debarment by NTPC, such Supplier shall not be eligible for evaluation. In case of debarment by any other entity except NTPC, such Supplier shall not be eligible for preference.
