A. **Scope of Work: 'Temporary Engagement of 5 Unskilled Manpower for Store Activities at Silchar Substation for 3 Months'** as per details, terms and conditions indicated in the bidding documents, in perfect condition, along with driver, all consumables, tools & tackles, spares and uniform of driver at the cost of the contractor. The detailed scope work shall be as per 'Scope of Work', 'Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC)' and as per instruction of Engineer/Officer-In-Charge and other relevant Clauses of the tender documents.

B. **Estimated charges per man day mentioned in the bid document is inclusive of Overhead charges (@7% of minimum wages, inclusive of GST) (except Contractor's profit). The Overhead Charges caters to the expenses to be incurred by the Contractor towards procuring labour license, compliance of PF & ESI, operational cost of contract including bank charges towards CPG, cost of manpower replacement as and when required, interest on the amount deducted from the running bills towards TDS, Security Deposit etc. and Cost of coordination / management of the labour engaged in the Contract etc. The above rate of Overhead Charges shall be fixed for entire duration of Contract.**

B. The bidder must be a 'Class-I local supplier' as defined under Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order as per bidding documents. Firms who are not 'Class-I local supplier shall not be eligible to bid. **Presently, the local content requirement to categorize a supplier as 'Class-I local supplier' is minimum 60%. The 'Class-I local supplier' shall give a self-certification in his bid in the given format, indicating the percentage of Local Content and certifying that the item offered meets the Local Content requirement for 'Class -I local supplier' and shall give details of the location(s) at which value addition is made.**

C. **It is the Employer's (POWERGRID's) policy that requires the bidder to sign a declaration along with its bid about abiding by a 'Code of Integrity for Public Procurement'. All bidders are required to submit the same as a part of their technical bid. This policy is detailed in the bidding documents.**

D. **Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC), Bid Forms and Qualification Requirements against this tender package is enclosed as "Buyer uploaded ATC document" to this bid document.**

H. Insurance Coverage:

All eligible contract labourers shall be mandatorily provided insurance coverage under the following schemes, in addition to ESI/EC benefits:

- Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY)
- Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY)

The cost of these insurance policies shall be reimbursed to the contractor by POWERGRID, subject to submission of valid payment receipts and policy documents.

I. Alternative Coverage for Non-ESI Labourers

In cases where contract labourers are not covered under ESI, a **Mediclaim policy** with a sum assured of **₹2,00,000 (Rupees Two Lakh)** each labourer and their dependent family members shall be provided as an alternative. The premium for this policy will also be reimbursed to the contractor by **POWERGRID**, upon submission of relevant documents.

J. Bonus Benefits

As a model employer, POWERGRID has decided to extend bonus benefits to all contract workers whose monthly wages exceed ₹21,000:

- The bonus shall be calculated at a maximum ceiling of 8.33% on ₹21,000.
- This amounts to ₹1,749.30 per month maximum.

K. Contractors have to take up workman compensation policy for the contract mandatorily.

L. Site information: It is imperative for bidder to satisfy himself completely of all local conditions. In addition, the Bidder are expected to assess any problems relating to the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and its availability, besides any other aspects including financial implication affecting the execution of the contract covered under these documents and specifications. A Bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site (whether he inspects or not) and no claim whatsoever on this account at any stage shall be entertained. Submission of Bid by a Bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other Tender Documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions as well as of local conditions and other factors which may have bearing on the execution of the works.

M. CPG/Security Deposit (SD): As a security towards satisfactory performance of the Contract, the successful Bidder, to whom the work is awarded, shall be required to furnish a Performance Guarantee in favour of the Owner within 28 days from the date of Contract order.

As an alternate option to CPG, pro-rata deductions @5% from the bills of the contractor, up-to 5% of the total contract value, shall be made towards Security Deposit in lieu of PBG; for which contractor shall confirm either of the options.

In case of any amendment to the contract, the Contract price, as amended, shall be the reference price for determining the value of Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit. The contractor shall accordingly, increase/decrease the Bank Guarantee/Security Deposit value submitted towards Contract Performance Guarantee based on the amended contract value. Security Deposit shall be returned to the Contractor on successful completion of the works under the Contract after 90-Ninety days of end of the contract validity period. No interest shall be payable to the Contractor against Security Deposit.

N. Issuing Banks: The Bank Guarantee for Performance Security are to be provided by the Service Provider which should be issued either by a Public Sector Bank located in India, or a scheduled Indian Bank having paid up capital (net of any accumulated losses) of Rs. 1,000 million or above (the latest annual report of the Bank should support compliance of capital adequacy ratio requirement) as per List of Banks enclosed.

O. "While executing the contract, the contractor shall stand comply with all requirements of Social Accountability Standards i.e. SA8000 (latest Standard available at www.sa-intl.org) and maintain the necessary records."

Q. - S. Bidders may note that the Owner (POWERGRID) has uploaded its 'Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure': Vol-I & Vol-II to POWERGRID's website. However, it shall be noted that no other party, including the Bidder/ Contractor, shall derive any right from this 'Works & Procurement Policy and Procedure' documents or have any claim on the Owner on the basis of the same. The respective rights of Owner and Bidders/ Contractors shall be governed by the bidding documents/ contracts signed between the Owner and the Contractor for the package. The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में

भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
