1.0 PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

The CAMSC is valid for a period of One Year from the date of issue of this Contract and is extendable for further period of One year upon mutual consent on the same rate, Terms and Conditions. ISRO H Q reserves the right to extend or curtail the period of Contract.

Vendors are requested to Inspect the machines available at ISRO HQ before submitting the bid. If any of the machine requires repair and spare parts, such list shall be provided to us so that we can procure the spares and arrange for repairing the machine and keep it ready before the start of CAMSC.

OEM Authorization Certificate has to be mandatorily submitted along with the quote for considering your bid.

2.0 SCOPE OF MAINTENANCE:

2.1 The scope of Comprehensive Service Contract includes preventive/corrective maintenance of Kyocera Colour Machine, attending unlimited break down calls and to provide all spares, consumables like toner, developer, drum except paper as and when required with no additional cost. Please indicate separately the spares that are covered under CAMSC and the spares that are not covered under CAMSC.

2.2 Preventive and corrective maintenance services shall be attended twice in a quarter [with a gap minimum 40 days] to keep the copier in good working condition. Repair and replacement of spares or parts and attending to repairs shall be undertaken as and when required.

2.3 The break down calls shall be attended to within 24 hours of intimation by the respective Section.

2.4 Discount on metered copies as applicable towards service and wastage shall be quoted.

3.0 PRICE:

The CAMSC rates shall be firm & fixed for a period of One year and extendable for further one more year upon mutual consent of both the parties on the same rate Terms and Conditions.

4.0 PAYMENT TERMS:

Payment shall be made on monthly basis as per the actual metered copies for each copier. Your invoices showing the details of meter reading (opening and closing) along with the service call report (with the details of spares replacement, if any) containing the details of services/repairs/replacement etc. duly certified by the Focal Point shall be submitted to Sr. Purchase & Stores Officer. The payment will be made within 30 days of receipt of Bills/Invoice.

5.0 DOWN-TIME COMPENSATION:

- 5.1 In case of any breakdown, the service provider shall arrange to rectify the defect within 24 hours from lodging of the complaint. In case of delay in attending to the breakdown beyond 24 hours, proportionate amount equivalent to the CAMSC charges of the machine shall be deducted from the payment due to the Service Provider.
- 5.2 In case, if the problem could not be resolved within a day, a standby machine of equivalent features shall be provided and the same shall be retained until the defective machine is brought to working conditions.
- 5.3 No CAMSC charges will be paid during the downtime and it will be deducted in proportion to 24 hours irrespective of holidays.

6.0 FAILURE OF CONTRACTOR:

ISRO HQ reserves the right to revoke the service Contract in part or in full or entrust the Contract with any other Contractor. In case the Contractor fails to comply with Contractual obligation during the currency of the Contract, the Contractor shall be responsible for any loss to the Service Receiver as a result of non-compliance of the Contractual obligations and breach of trust.

8.0 GENERAL TERMS:

- 8.1 All the defective parts removed from the Machine being the property of vendor, the parts shall be taken out of ISRO HQ premises with proper Gate Passes. Defective parts can be taken out after replacing it with the genuine ones.
- 8.2 In the event of damages to Department's property or personal injury to ISRO HQ/Contractor's personnel due to the negligence of the Contractor's employees, the responsibility solely rests with the Contractor. The Department shall not be responsible for any injury/loss of life to the Contractor's personnel due to accidents/natural calamities, etc., at ISRO HQ premises.
- 8.3 The Contractor shall make his own arrangement for transport, canteen, safety of their personnel, medical and other amenities.
- 8.4 The Contractor shall observe the security regulations of the Department and any loss or damage incurred by the Department on account of the Contractor's failure of any nature to observe the security regulations, it shall be debitable to Contractor's account.
- 8.5 The maintenance services shall be attended during normal working hours between 0930 and 1700 hrs [Monday through Friday].
- 8.6 Change of Location of Copier: In case, if the Kyocera Colour Machine is to be removed from the present location to any other location, the Contractor will be intimated in advance.

9.0 FALL CLAUSE:

The charges quoted by the Contractor shall in no event exceed the lowest charges at which the Contractor maintain system (s) of identical description to any other party(ies) during the period of this Contract. If at any time, during the said period, the Contractor reduce the maintenance charges of such machine to any other customer, it shall forthwith be notified to ISRO HQ and the charges payable

le under the Contract for the servicing done after the date of coming into force of such reduction of maintenance charges shall stand correspondingly reduced.

10.0 PARALLEL/ADHOC CONTRACT:

ISRO HQ reserves the right to enter into parallel Contract(s) simultaneously or at anytime during the period of this Contract with one or more Service Providers and to place adhoc Contract or Contract simultaneously or at any time during the period of this Contract with one or more Service Provider.

11.0 SUBLETTING OF CONTRACT:

The Contract shall not be sublet, transferred or assigned to any other firm without the prior written approval of ISRO HQ.

12.0 DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM:

(A) CONCILIATION: Notwithstanding anything contained in this Contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties, shall be resolved through Conciliation.

(B) MEDIATION: Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably through Conciliation, then either of the parties, may approach for mediation to settle under Mediation Act, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescribed in the Mediation Act, 2023 amended from time to time.

(C) ARBITRATION: In the event of any dispute/s, difference/s or claim/s arising out of or relating to the interpretation and application of the Contract, such dispute/s or difference/s or claim/s shall be settled amicably by mutual consultations of the good Offices of the respective Parties and recognizing their mutual interests attempt to reach a solution satisfactory to both the parties. If such a resolution is not possible, within 30 days from the date of receipt of written notice of the existence of such dispute/s, then the unresolved dispute/s or difference/s or claim/s shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Parties by mutual consent in accordance with the rules and procedures of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended from time to time. The arbitration shall be conducted in Bengaluru in the Arbitration and Conciliation Centre - Bengaluru (Domestic and International) as per its rules and regulations. The expenses for the Arbitration shall be shared equally or as may be determined by the Arbitrator. The considered and written decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding between the Parties. The applicable language for Arbitration shall be English only. Work under the Contract shall be continued by the CONTRACTOR during the pendency of arbitration proceedings, without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with the decision of the Arbitrator unless otherwise directed in writing by the DEPARTMENT or unless the matter is such that the works cannot be possibly continued until the decision (whether final or interim) of the Arbitrator is obtained. Arbitration will be a method of dispute resolution in Contracts where dispute value is lesser than Rs.10 Crore.

If the arbitrator is the Head of the Purchase Office: (i) In the event of his being transferred or vacating his office by resignation or otherwise, it shall be lawful for his successor in office either to proceed with the reference himself or to appoint another person as arbitrator, or In the event of his being unwilling or unable to act for any reason, it shall be lawful for the Head of the Purchase Office to appoint another person as arbitrator.

If the arbitrator is a person appointed by the Head of the Purchase Office, In the event of his denying or neglecting or refusing to act, or resigning or being unable to act, for any reason, shall be lawful for the Head of the Purchase Office either to proceed with the reference himself or to appoint another person as arbitrator in place of the outgoing arbitrator subject, as aforesaid, to the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, and the rules thereunder and any statutory modifications thereof or the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceeding under the clause. The Arbitrator shall have the power to extend with the consent of the Purchaser and the Contractor the time for making and publishing the award. The venue of arbitration shall be the place as the Purchaser in his absolute discretion may determine. Work under the Contract shall, if reasonably pos

sible, continue during Arbitration Proceedings.

13.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non-performance of any of his obligations (except for failure to pay any sum which has become due on account of receipt of goods under the provisions of the present Purchase Order/Contract) if the non-performance results from such force majeure circumstances such as, but not restricted to, flood, fire, earthquake, civil commotion, sabotage, explosion, epidemic, quarantine restriction, strike, lock-out, freight embargo, acts of the Government either in sovereign or Contractual capacity, hostility, acts of public enemy and other acts of god as well as war or revolution, military operation, blockade, acts or actions of State authorities or any other circumstance beyond the control of the parties that have arisen after the conclusion of the present Purchase Order/Contract. In such circumstances, the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the Purchase order/Contract may be proportionately extended. The party for whom it becomes impossible to meet the obligation under this Contract due to force majeure condition, will notify the other party in writing not later than twenty-one days from the date of commencement of the unforeseeable event. Unless otherwise directed by the Centre/unit in writing, the Contractor/Supplier shall continue to perform his obligations under the purchase order/Contracts as far as is practical and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the force majeure event. Any Certificate issued by the chamber of commerce or any other competent authority or organization of the respective country shall be sufficient proof of commencement and cessation of the above circumstances. The force majeure conditions are applicable only to the prime Contractor and Purchaser.

14.0 SHORT CLOSING & TERMINATION:

Under the normal circumstances, Termination/Short closing of the Contract is not foreseen. However, in case of continued non-performance of the Contract, ISRO HQ reserves the right to terminate the Contract wholly or partly by giving written notice of not less than 30 days. ISRO HQ reserves the right to terminate the Contract at any time by giving 30 days prior notice without assigning any reasons.

15.0 APPLICABLE LAW & JURISDICTION:

The Contract shall be interpreted, construed and governed by the laws of India. The Courts within Bangalore only shall have jurisdiction to deal with and decide on any matter arising out of the Contract.

16.0 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT & ACCEPTANCE:

Please acknowledge the receipt of this CAMSC and its acceptance shall be confirmed by returning the duplicate copy signed and stamped.
