Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

5. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. 2 MATERIAL TO BE SUPPLIED BY THE CORPORATION (CLAUSE 15.0.0 OF GCC): No material shall be supplied by the Corporation. The Contractor at his own expenses, provide/ arrange all materials.

3 DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD (CLAUSE NO. 34.0 OF GCC): Defect liability period shall be One **(01)** months from the date of certified completion of the work.

4 WATER SUPPLY: - Corporation will provide water supply free of cost to be consumed at the job site for execution of work only. However, if it is not provided, contractor must make his own arrangement without any extra cost to the Corporation to complete the entire work within time schedule.

The Engineer-in-Charge shall then arrange to have the bill verified by taking or causing to be taken where necessary, the requisite measurement of the work.

Payment of contractor's bill shall be made by the corporation within 15 days from the date of submission of the bill duly certified by Engineer-in-Charge & certification of Quality surveillance by QA representatives.
