Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. 2. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Scope of Supply

5	Before submitting the bid, bidders must thoroughly research the geographical location, logistical accessibility, and transport routes to the site. Quoted rates must be entirely inclusive of GST, all applicable taxes, duties, and comprehensive transportation/freight charges from the seller's facility to the consignee location at Campbell Bay, Andaman & Nicobar Islands . The rates quoted should be valid for the entire period of contract. The department will not have any responsibilities for the hike in the price during the contract period. The agency shall be allowed payment as per the accepted rates by the department.
6	Eligibility Criteria :

15	After testing and commissioning the Forklift may be handed over to the Assistant Engineer (Mech), Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works, Campbell Bay.

16	Bidders may please quote their unconditional rates strictly as per schedule of work and Terms & Conditions. The rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees and rounded off to its nearest value.
17	The Forklift will be inspected including conducting load test by the Deputy Chief Engineer (Mech)/Executive Engineer (CSWD) or his authorized representative of ALHW at the factory at manufacturers end in mainland.
18	The Forklift should be guaranteed for a period of one year from the date of commissioning against manufacturing defects of usage of sub standard spares/raw materials. Defects if any found during the Guarantee period should be made good by the agency on free of cost immediately.
19	2.5% of Security deposit, 2% of TDS GST and 2% of IT and any other statutory deduction as per GoI rules, will be deducted from the bill amount. SD will be released on completion of guarantee period. The guarantee period will be one year from the date of commissioning of the Forklift at ALHW, Campbell Bay.
20	The following items shall be handed over to the Assistant Engineer (Mech), ALHW, Campbell Bay. 1. Operator Manual – 02 sets 2. Maintenance Manual – 02 sets 3. Parts catalogue – 02 sets 4. Tools Kit – 01 set
21	Local labours may be engaged for the erection purpose. Engineers and Skilled Technician shall be arranged from mainland.
22	Cranes and Forklifts will be provided at Campbell Bay by The Assistant Engineer (Mech), Campbell Bay on free of hire charges subject to availability for the erection and commissioning works. Special tools required for the erection work shall be arranged by the Bidder.
23	ALHW will not provide any transportation and accommodation. Bidder shall arrange transportation and accommodation to their Engineers, technician and other officials at their own cost. Transportation also may be arranged at their own cost, hence the agency may keep in mind such contingency while quoting the rate.
24	The bid will be followed as per the Latest SoP of CPWD Works Manual, Procurement manuals as amended from time to time after awarding of contract and GCC 2023 for other terms conditions etc.,
25	The sub standard / damaged / rejected materials shall be removed from the office immediately and replaced at their own cost and risk.
26	On successful completion of work, necessary invoice may be generated through GeM against the officers mentioned in the GeM contract along with latest GSTR3B & guarantee certificate for the forklift for generating CRAC in GEM Portal for arranging e-payment.
27	ALHW may, by order in writing, impose restrictions, including prior registration and /or screening, on procurement from bidders from a country or countries, or a class of countries, on grounds of defense of India, or matters directly or indirectly related thereto including national security; no procurement shall be made in violation of such restrictions.
28	Employer's Right to accept any Bid and Reject any or All Bids Notwithstanding, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to cancel the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder of the grounds for the Employer's action.
