3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be relaxed from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.
5. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
6. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
7. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
8. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. 9. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the

manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

10. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

Bidder(In case Manufacturer/OEM of offered Product) shall submit undertaking that Fabric & Retroreflective Tape used by manufacturer are in compliance/meeting the parameters defined in IS 15809:2017 along with Test Reports for the fabric and retroreflective tape issued by a laboratory that is either (i) NABL accredited for the relevant tests, or (ii) BIS recognized/empanelled for testing under IS 15809:2017, confirming compliance with the applicable requirements of IS 15809:2017.

In case Bidder is not Manufacturer/OEM of offered product, Bidder shall submit undertaking from Manufacturer/OEM along with documents mentioned above.

Non- Compliance of above shall result in rejection of Bid.

6. Manufacturer/OEM Authorisation for Bid Participation: In case of Resellers/Traders, Bidder shall submit OEM Authorisation for Bid Participation.

Non- Compliance of above shall result in rejection of Bid.

7. Bidder shall submit Data Sheet of the product offered specifying information including but not Limited to:

- a) Image of the product.
- b) Brand (Manufacturer Info) of Offered product
- c) BIS License No of Manufacturer
- d) GSM of Fabric used

8. Penalty Clause :

A.) For delayed delivery, 0.5 % per week or part thereof of the Contract value(Value calculated based on portion of Contract not Delivered excluding Taxes) subject to a maximum of 10% of the Contract value shall be recovered after due notification.

B.) Delayed replacement of High Visibility Vest : In case Bidder do not replace High Visibility Vest notified to Bidder during Warranty Period within 15 Days ,value of same shall be deducted from Security Deposit.

9. Bid Security (EMD): EMD of the successful bidder shall be refunded

without any interest whatsoever, after receipt of Security Deposit or Bank Guarantee in lieu thereof from the vendor. EMD is acceptable in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, or payment Online in an acceptable form.

EMD of a bidder will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends its bid after the due date, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect, or declines to accept or honour the Purchase Order / contract if awarded in his favour within the Bid validity period. If the successful bidder fails to furnish Security Deposit or Bank Guarantee within the specified period, its EMD is liable to be forfeited.

10. Sample Approval: Bidder shall get sample approved within 10 Days post issuance of Contract. Time Period of 10 Days is excluded from Delivery Period mentioned in the Bid Document.

11. Eligibility for MSE Benefits:

A. Applicability of Benefits

Benefits available to eligible Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), including exemption from Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) and relaxation in the prescribed prior turnover and/or prior experience criteria, wherever such relaxation is specifically provided for in this Bid, shall be admissible only in accordance with the applicable

ble provisions of the Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012, as amended from time to time, the applicable provisions of the General Financial Rules (GFR), and the relevant instructions/guidelines issued by the Government of India/Department of Expenditure.

B. For availing MSE benefits under this Bid, the bidder shall:

- a. be registered as a Micro or Small Enterprise under a valid Udyam Registration Certificate on the date of bid submission;
- b. have a manufacturing activity reflected in its Udyam Registration having a direct and reasonable nexus with the High Visibility Vest being procured; and
- c. be the actual manufacturer of the High Visibility Vest offered under this Bid.

C. Relevance of Manufacturing Activity

The manufacturing activity reflected in the bidder's Udyam Registration should relate to the manufacture of High Visibility Vests, PPE, safety garments, protective clothing, workwear, textile garments or other similar products relevant to the subject matter of this Bid.

However, mere registration for the manufacture of PPE, safety garments, protective clothing, workwear or similar products shall not by itself entitle a bidder to claim MSE benefits unless the bidder is also the actual manufacturer of the High Visibility Vest offered under this Bid.

D. Exclusion of Traders and Suppliers of Another Manufacturer's Product

A bidder merely acting as a Trader, Dealer, Reseller, Distributor, Stockist, Agent, Authorised Representative or Intermediary, or a bidder offering High Visibility Vests manufactured by another entity, shall not be eligible to claim MSE benefits under this Bid.

E. Relaxation in Prior Turnover and Prior Experience Criteria

An eligible MSE may avail relaxation in the prescribed prior turnover and/or prior experience criteria, wherever applicable under the Bid and the relevant Government of India guidelines.

Such relaxation shall not result in any relaxation or dilution of the prescribed technical specifications, quality standards, statutory requirements, testing requirements, performance requirements or any other essential requirements of the Bid.

F. Documentary Evidence and Verification

The bidder claiming MSE benefits shall submit a valid Udyam Registration Certificate and such documentary evidence as may be required by AIASL to establish its MSE status, relevant manufacturing activity and manufacturing capability.

AIASL reserves the right to verify the Udyam Registration, manufacturing capability and eligibility of the bidder for the MSE benefits claimed.

G. Incorrect or Unsupported Claim

In case the claim for MSE benefits is found to be incorrect, false, misleading or unsupported at any stage of the procurement process, the benefits claimed shall be liable to be withdrawn and AIASL may take appropriate action, including rejection of the Bid or cancellation of the Contract, as per the applicable Bid conditions and Government rules.

H. Final Determination

The determination of eligibility for availing MSE benefits, including the relevance of the manufacturing activity and verification that the bidder is the actual manufacturer of the High Visibility Vest offered under this Bid, shall be made by AIASL based on the documents submitted by the bidder and any verification considered necessary.

The decision of AIASL in this regard shall be final and binding, subject to the applicable rules and law.

12. Eligibility for Availing Start-up Benefits:

Benefits available to eligible Startups, including exemption from EMD/Bid Security and relaxation in the prescribed prior turnover and/or prior experience criteria, shall be admissible in accordance with the applicable provisions of GFR 2017, the Manual for Procurement of Goods – Second Edition, 2024, and the guidelines/instructions issued by DPIIT and the Government of India, as amended from time to time.

A bidder claiming Startup benefits shall submit a valid DPIIT Recognition Certificate and shall be eligible for such benefits only if the following conditions are fulfilled:

- a. The bidder is a valid DPIIT-recognised Startup on the date of bid submission and is otherwise eligible to avail Startup benefits under the applicable Government guidelines.
- b. The bidder shall be the actual manufacturer of the High Visibility Vest offered under this Bid. Startup benefits shall not be admissible merely on the basis of DPIIT recognition where the offered High Visibility Vest is manufactured by another entity and is merely sourced, procured or supplied by the bidder.
- c. The bidder claiming Startup benefits shall submit documentary evidence, wherever required by AIASL, to establish its manufacturing capability and confirm that it is the manufacturer of the offered High Visibility Vest.
- d. A bidder acting merely as a Trader, Dealer, Reseller, Distributor, Stockist, Agent, Authorised Representative or Intermediary for another manufacturer shall not be eligible to claim Startup benefits under this Bid. Relaxation in prior turnover and/or prior experience, wherever admissible under the applicable Government guidelines, shall not result in relaxation of the prescribed technical specifications, quality standards, statutory requirements, testing requirements, performance requirements or any other essential requirement of the Bid.
- e. AIASL reserves the right to verify the validity of the DPIIT Recognition Certificate, the manufacturing capability of the bidder and whether the offered High Visibility Vest is actually manufactured by the bidder. In case the claim for Startup benefits is found to be incorrect or unsupported, the benefits claimed may be withdrawn and appropriate action, including rejection of the Bid or cancellation of the Contract, may be taken as per the applicable Bid conditions and Government rules.

The decision of AIASL regarding the eligibility of a bidder for Startup benefits shall be final and binding, subject to the applicable rules and law.
