1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

3. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any

purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

5. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

OPTION CLAUSE 25% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider

2. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

3. Past Project Experience

Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause: For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.b. Execution certificate by client with contract value.c. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.Proof for Past Experience and Project Experience clause: For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:a. 4. Service & Support

In the event where the distance travelled exceeds the monthly usage variant, amount will be paid for additional Kms as per schedule. Similarly, the unused Kms in a particular month as against the minimum guaranteed usage variant will be carried forward to the next month and additional Km if any in the next month shall be adjusted against this. However, the payment for the selected usage variant in a month will be paid every month." Further, the unused Kms in a particular month shall not be carried forward or adjusted beyond 6 months

5. Forms of EMD and PBG

Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of

A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.

SPECIAL TERM and CONDITIONS FOR VEHICLE HIRING CONTRACT (Annexure to DGM(G)/SER's Memo No. SER-HQOGM(TC72)/2/2024-0/ o DGM(G)/GRC/SER (Comp. No: 250496) dated 21.05.2025)

1.	The vehicle must be commercially registered as per Motor Vehicle Act and have valid insurance certificate & Pollution Under Control (PUC) certificate . The liability and risk of composite insurance covering vehicle theft, damage, injury of passengers and public due to accident etc. are responsibility of the Contractor only.
2.	Vehicle should not be older than 3 calendar years , e.g if bid opening date in years 2025, then vehicle registration year allowed should be 2025, 2024, 2023, 2022. At any point of time, vehicles should not be older than 5 years and the vehicle should be BS-VI or latest.
3.	A name plate of suitable size is required to be made and fitted on the front of the vehicle. The name plate should read "On Duty, Ministry of Railway, Govt. of India" .
4.	Vehicle colour should be white / white base colours. The vehicle should be mechanically sound and shall be well maintained with neat and clean interior/exterior and hygienic. Three pairs of seat-covers and towels to be changed on alternate days.
5.	Driver should be provided with white shirt and white pant. The cost of uniforms is to be borne by the contractor.
6.	The driver must have the valid driving license, must possess good driving skill, obedient and courteous. Driver should not be suffering from hyperhidrosis or any other medical conditions resulting in foul body odour. Medical Certificate to this effect should be provided. The driver must be literate, having good knowledge of roads, navigation skills and familiarities with traffic rules and regulations and should be able to communicate properly. He should also be able to do the day-to-day maintenance of the vehicle's cleanliness and functionality. Driver must have adequate control and patience and remain calm and composed even in stressful traffic situations and should never be a part of road rage or reckless driving.

7.	All other terms and conditions of the contract for Hiring of Vehicles, which are not specified; Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC), will be governed by Service level Agreement (SLA) for monthly basis cab & taxi hiring services of GeM Portal.
8.	The vehicle should be available for any outstation duty during the Contract Period. The toll charges and other taxes for the outstation duty will be borne by the contractor. On production of toll receipt, the amount will be reimbursed by Railways.
9.	In case of any break-down of the vehicle or in any other situation such as the firm fails to provide the allocated category/model of vehicle, the firm must provide a higher category/model of vehicle as an alternative for stop-gap arrangement.
10.	The tenderer shall submit their official address, Mobile / phone nos., e-mails, & Fax No. (if any) and the driver's mobile number for communication.
11.	Driver should have a mobile phone with round the clock availability (24*7) to attend movement/program details of the vehicle. Service provider should bear the charges regarding Phone call/SMS communication with the user.
12.	Driver should not use mobile phone during driving in emergency situation; he should park the vehicle and talk/communicate with the permission of the occupant/passenger.
13.	The Railway in no case shall be responsible for any legal matters arising out of any State or Central Govt. laws/ rules in the matters of employing the driver by vehicle's owner/Contractor.
14.	The contractor shall bear the cost of repair or renewal of any kind of Railway properties if damaged by driver's negligence in rough driving, carelessness. In regard to assessment of such loss on account of damages, the decision of the Officer for whom vehicle is hired or his representative will be considered as final and binding on the Contractors.
15.	Contractor shall be fully responsible for any repair, accident, loss and damages to the vehicle and driver. If any fine or penalty is imposed by various authorities such as Road Transport Officers/Authorities, Traffic police etc. for any violation such as speed, traffic rules violation etc., the same will have to be borne by the contractor only.
16.	All hired vehicles should be equipped with prescribed emergency kit and a fire extinguisher as per statutory provision.
17.	No sub-contracting shall be allowed in any case. Vehicles should be in the name of the bidder and no subletting would be permitted.

18.	The contractor shall submit the bill for the month or part thereof by 7 th of the following month. The bill must accompany the certification of the officer/secretary to PHODs/CHODs/AGM/DRM using the vehicles having day-wise use and kilometer of use and also furnish other documents such as Toll tax, Parking fees which need to be countersigned by the officer.
19.	However, any penalty or fines etc. imposed by RTA, Police or other law enforcing agencies due to failure/violation of traffic rules etc. are not payable to the contractor and such risk and cost will be borne by the contractor.
20.	Other terms and condition will be as per GeM SLA, GeM GCC and other conditions shall be as per GeM updated from time to time.

ADDITIONAL SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF VEHICLE HIRING CONTRACT:

1.	The 01 No. SUV Vehicles are required for Sr.DEN(South)/RNC with staff for two years (24 months).
2.	The time of completion of the work will be given in the bid document.
3.	The rate includes all major/minor repairs serving of Commercially Registered vehicle, cost of fuel, lubricants and any other consumables required from time to time. Driver's salary and all allowance, all taxes, duties, incidental charges, penalties etc. as imposed by Central/States/Local Government bodies for running of Commercially Registered vehicles to be borne by the contractor without any liability on Railways.
4.	(i) The vehicle should be made readily available from 8.00 AM to 08.00 PM normally. However, railway can ask for any hours to any hours as per its requirement with the Driver, fuel and all necessities etc. No extra payment shall be made for extra hours, night allowance etc. (ii) Any less utilization on hourly basis in any day will be carried forward to next month. Similarly, any extra hour is utilization will be adjusted in next month. (iii) Contractor will be paid only the contractual amount of this instant tender. Parking fees if any, shall be borne by the contractor and the contractor shall bear all costs for fuel/lubricants, running repairs, servicing, vehicle or accessories, major repair, overhauling and servicing, maintenance of the vehicle and the Octroi toll tax as and when required.

5.	No accommodation will be provided by the Railway to the driver; he has to make his own arrangements for boarding and lodging.
6.	Driver of the Commercially Registered vehicle shall maintain a Log Book indicating following particulars- (a) Date (b) From and to (c) Km (d) Name of the Railway official using (e) Signature (f) Purpose of journey (g) Remarks.
7.	That the contractor agrees to indemnify the Railway Administration against all claims for compensation by or on behalf of driver employed by him in connection with the present contract for any injury or death by an accident under the workmen's compensation Act. VIII of 1923 and the Railway Administration will be entitled to deduct from any sum of money due or payable to the contractor the amount of compensation thus payable, under the terms of section 12 of the said Act. Together with all or any cost incurred by the Railway Administration in such connection and the contractor further agrees that the decision of the Engineer-in-charge with respect to the amount of such indemnity shall be accepted by him finally.
8.	All other charges of Central Govt./State Govt./any other authority, if any, are borne by the successful tenderer.
9.	"Govt. of India" board should be fixed on the Commercially Registered vehicle prominently.
10.	No extra payment shall be made on account of increase/decrease in the rate of Fuel, lubricants, labour wages or any other taxes etc. No extra payment shall be made for use of vehicle on holidays and Sundays.
11.	Railway reserves the right to decrease/increase the number of hired vehicle at any time during currency of contract.
12.	In case the vehicle is detained out of station overnight, the railway will provide no accommodation & no night duty allowance nor any compensation or whatsoever for driver and contractor.
13.	Any claim, compensation arising out of any accident/injury to any person/party will be the liability of contractors and / or any litigation arising out of running /accident of vehicle or due to the person employed by the contractor etc. shall be dealt by contractor himself at his own cost. Railway will not bear any liability on any account.
14.	The contractor shall ensure that all the meters particularly the Milometer/Speedometer and other devices of vehicle are always in working condition. In case of any defect, the contractor at his own cost may rectify the same. For the interim period the contractor shall arrange another vehicle so that the Railway's work does not get hampered.
15.	The contractor shall provide a spare wheel and necessary tools in good working condition.

16.	In the event of the breakdown of the vehicle en-route, the cost and responsibility of transporting the incumbent of the vehicle to his destination shall be borne by the contractor.
17.	First Aid Box with all necessary consumable items should be made available all the time by the Contractor and periodically he/they should inspect and recoup the same and necessary entry should also be made in Log Book. The drivers and passengers safety belts should also be provided by the contractors. Damaged, broken and over aged belt should also be replaced by the contractor.
18.	Frequent change of driver is not acceptable. Prior intimation to executive before changing of driver is mandatory. At least 3 days before change of driver, intimation is required to competent authority.
19.	The driver of every vehicle must deposit any proof of identity like Voter card/Adhaar card etc as an original copy till completion of contract. It will return to concerned drivers after completion of currency of contract.
20.	Cost of FASTags/Night charges/Octroi/Toll Tax/ Parking Charges/Driver allowances or any other charges shall be borne by the service provider. No extra charges will be payable other than finalised contract rate. Mandatory FASTags experience shall be borne by the service provider, Railway will not bear any such type of cost.
21.	Penalty: Penalty for late arrival of vehicle/driver and other type of defaults shall be levied as mentioned in SLA Details for Vehicle Hiring through G eM.
22.	Special Condition of Contract for any financial documents attested/certified by CA: - The balance sheet and all other financial documents attested/certified by CAs to substantiate fulfilment of Financial Eligibility Criteria should be with UDIN, failing which the offer is likely to be rejected without any further reference. (Authority: CE's letter No.- CE/G/Arb& Cont. Mgt./Tender Circular/P t.1/317, Dated: 11:03.2025)
23.	If the contract of any agency is terminated solely on account of non-performance by them, the same agency will be debarred for participation in any of the tender in Ranchi Division for 02 years from the date of termination.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs

However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**

- All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

This Bid is governed by the General Terms and Conditions, conditions stipulated in Bid and Service Level Agreement specific to the Service, as the case may be, as provided in the Marketplace.

However, in case of Service, if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement specific to said Service, then it will over-ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

This Bid is governed by the [सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions](#), conditions stipulated in Bid and [Service Level Agreement](#) specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.
